MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Sibling Tuition Discount – oldest student in family will pay full tuition. All siblings will be discounted 10% of his/her tuition.

NCS Preschool to Kindergarten/LEAP Transition Discount – students enrolled in the NCS Preschool 4's program will be granted a one-time 5% discount to be applied towards Kindergarten or LEAP tuition. This discount does not apply to NCS Faculty and Staff nor any other fees. Monthly payments for those not paying tuition in full will commence in June.

Tuition payments – balances not paid in full by April 10, 2012 must be made through FACTS by bank draft or credit card. There is a \$41 setup fee for this service.

Credit card payments – will incur a convenience fee.

Tuition Assistance – online application is separate from the enrollment process. Please go to www.factstuitionaid.com. The deadline for application is February 29, 2012. For additional information please contact the Business Office.

Tuition Financing Options –

- 1) One payment in full by April 10, 2012
- 2) Six monthly payments beginning May 2012
- 3) Eleven monthly payments beginning May 2012
- 4) Extended financing terms up to 84 months with an educational loan through **Your Tuition Solution**. For additional information or to apply visit their web site at www.tuitionsolution.com. This company provides loans at a low fixed rate starting at 5.99%. There are no prepayment penalties or application fees.

Tuition Refund Policy – after a student has been in attendance for ten academic days during the school year, full tuition and all other fees are non-refundable. If the student withdraws or is otherwise dismissed from NCS, all payments shall be retained by NCS and, further, the remaining balance of tuition and all other fees shall be immediately due and payable.

New Family Referral Tuition Credit – is intended to encourage existing families to refer new students to Northland Christian School. Only one existing family will be credited for referring a new family. In order for the referring family to receive the \$500 tuition credit, the *New Family Referral* form must be signed and dated by the referring family and submitted with the new student's *Application For Admission*. Once the new family has been enrolled for one semester, the referring family will receive the \$500 tuition credit. This referral credit has no cash value, can be carried forward one year, and is non-transferable. Only one \$500 tuition credit will be issued per new family.

ADDITIONAL FEES

- A limited number of middle and high school classes require special equipment or supplies (e.g. jazz ensemble, art, photography). Special class fees may be assessed depending on class requirements.
- Optional educational, athletic, and service trips are offered each year. These include academic meets, fine arts competitions, European travel, senior trip, and others events. The cost of these trips is not included in tuition.
- Elementary class activity fees range from \$35 to \$90 per semester, depending on grade level.
- Secondary Activity Fee - This fee is used to fund transportation equipment, special transportation for trips, teacher / coach stipends and special equipment or needs associated with extracurricular activities. This fee is non-refundable.
- A summer program is provided for K-6th grade students. A variety of sports, fine arts, and academic camps are conducted for middle and high school students. Programs and rates are announced during the spring each year.
- AP and Dual Credit courses have additional fees which are not included in tuition.
- Seniors will be assessed additional fees.
