Enrollment Fees:

Application/Testing Fee \$150:

per new student; due with application; non-refundable

Annual Enrollment Fee \$450:

due by February 1, 2010 or upon acceptance; non-refundable

Enrollment Late Fee \$150:

beginning February 2, 2010; non-refundable; applies to returning students only

Additional Fees:

Optional Tuition Insurance: 3.3% of total tuition due

The following fees apply to grades 6-12:

Anytime Anywhere Learning Program Fees

(formerly One-to-One Laptop Program)

The Instructional Fee and Technology Fee allow us to provide a wide array of current and relevant instructional materials to meet the needs of our students. The difference between the two fees is that the Instructional Fee includes the use of an NCS-owned MacBook computer. These fees are non-refundable.

Annual Technology Fee \$275:

applies to students with parent-owned MacBooks; due by June 1, 2010

OR

Annual Instructional Fee \$875:

applies only to students who chose to rent an NCS-owned MacBook in 2009-2010 - *option to choose this program no longer available if not currently renting*; due June 1, 2010

Instructional / Technology Late Fee \$100:

applied if fees not paid by June 1, 2010, non-refundable

Annual Secondary Activity Fee \$200:

due by June 1, 2010; non-refundable

MacBook Computer Cost*:

13" - 15" MacBook Computer \$1,230 - \$1,883

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Sibling Tuition Discount – oldest student in family will pay full tuition. All siblings will be discounted 10% of his/her tuition.

NCS Preschool to Kindergarten/LEAP transition discount – Students enrolled in the NCS Preschool 4's program will be granted a one-time 5% discount to be applied towards Kindergarten or LEAP tuition. This discount does not apply to NCS Faculty and Staff nor any other fees. Monthly payments for those not paying tuition in full will commence in June.

Tuition payments – balances not paid in full by May 3, 2010 must be made through FACTS by bank draft or credit card. There is a \$41 setup fee for this service.

Credit card payments – will incur a convenience fee.

Tuition assistance – application is separate from the enrollment process. The deadline for application is February 28, 2010. For additional information please contact the business office.

Tuition refund policy – after a student has been in attendance for ten academic days during the school year, full tuition and all other fees are non-refundable. If the student withdraws or is otherwise dismissed from NCS, all payments shall be retained by NCS and, further, the remaining balance of tuition and all other fees shall be immediately due and payable.

Tuition Insurance – sometimes situations arise which require the student to withdraw from school during the academic year. Since payment for tuition is unconditional, it is in the best interest of parents / guardians to seek some form of tuition relief should one of these situations arise. Tuition insurance provides a means to recover a percentage of the fees paid for unused services if a student withdraws after the first ten days of classes. NCS offers this service via a third party provider. Deadline to apply for this coverage is August 1, 2010.

ADDITIONAL FEES

- A limited number of middle and high school classes require special equipment or supplies (e.g. jazz ensemble, art, photography). Special class fees may be assessed depending on class requirements.
- Optional educational, athletic, and service trips are offered each year. These include academic meets, fine arts competitions, European travel, senior trip, and others. The cost of these trips is not included in tuition.
- Elementary class activity fees range from \$35 to \$90 per semester, depending on grade level.
- Secondary Activity Fee - This fee is used to fund transportation equipment, special transportation for trips, teacher / coach stipends and special equipment or needs associated with extracurricular activities. This fee is non-refundable.
- A summer program is provided for K-6th grade students. A variety of sports, fine arts, and academic camps are conducted for middle and high school students. Programs and rates are announced during the spring each year.
- AP and Dual Credit courses have additional fees which are not included in tuition.
- Seniors will be assessed additional fees.
