Program Details

The Northland Christian School Preschool Program is designed to be a fun learning environment for children ages 18 months through 5 years of age. The program includes daily curriculum with Bible lessons, songs, finger plays, arts and crafts, group and individual play. Opportunities for letter and number recognition, science, social studies and other areas of preschool learning will be explored. Fine and gross motor skill development is supported and special activities are planned that will provide hours of fun and entertainment. The teachers are loving, trained professionals who enjoy teaching in a Christ-centered environment. This nine week summer program is June 8 - August 7, 2009 with two-day (Tuesday/Thursday), three-day (Monday/Wednesday/Friday), and five-day options available. The regular program day is 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. with extended day hours available (6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.).

Extended care is available at a daily rate on an as-needed basis, a.m. \$9 per day and p.m. \$18 per day.

** **Transition Weeks** - June 1-5, 2009 and August 10-14, 2009. Care is available the first week of June before the summer program begins and the week in August after the summer program ends.

- A Change Fee of \$50 will be incurred if changes are made that reduce hours and/or days enrolled. Reduced program costs are calculated through the end of the month.

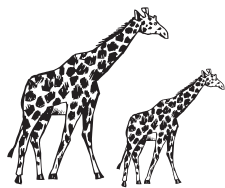


"Under the Big Top" July 6 - 10
