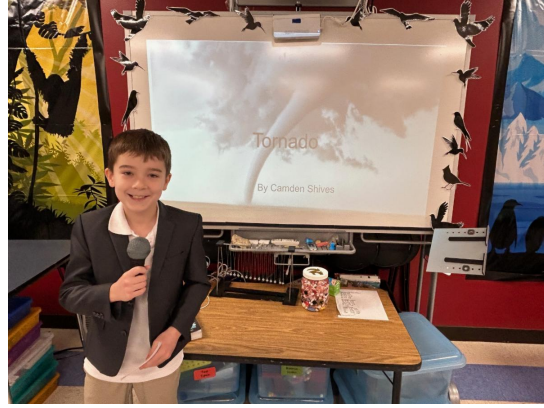
Fifth Grade Field Trip

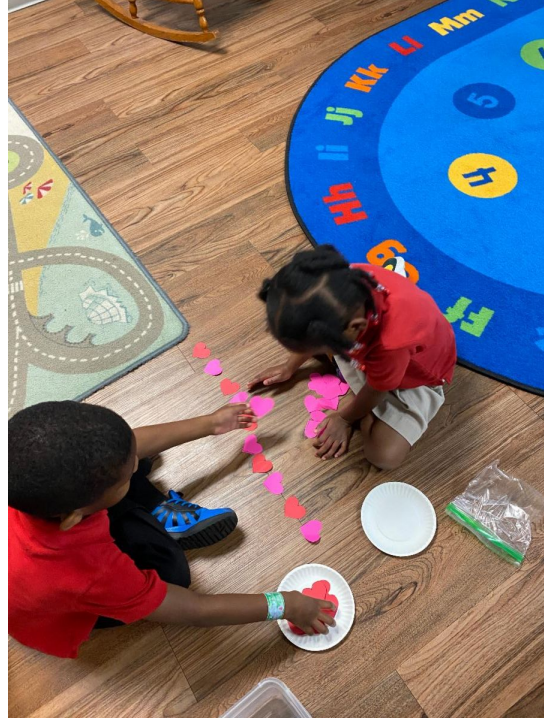


Music

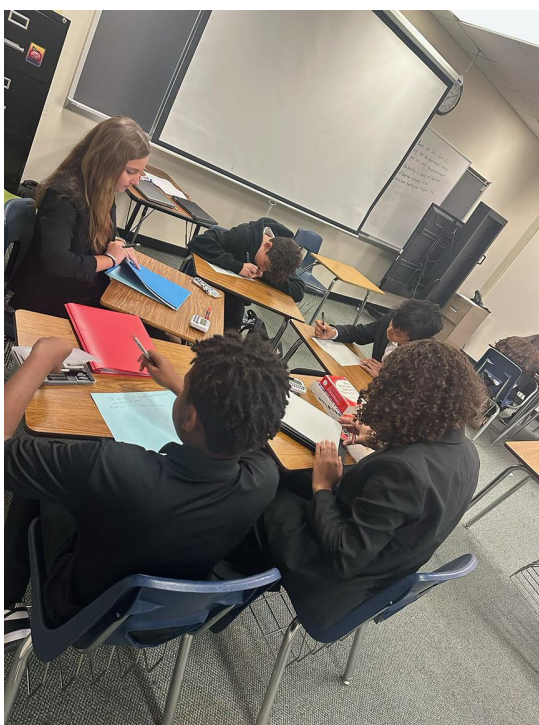

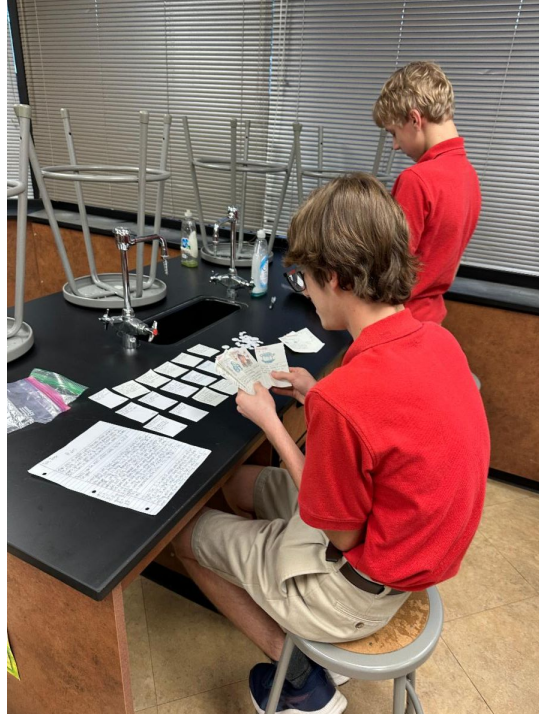
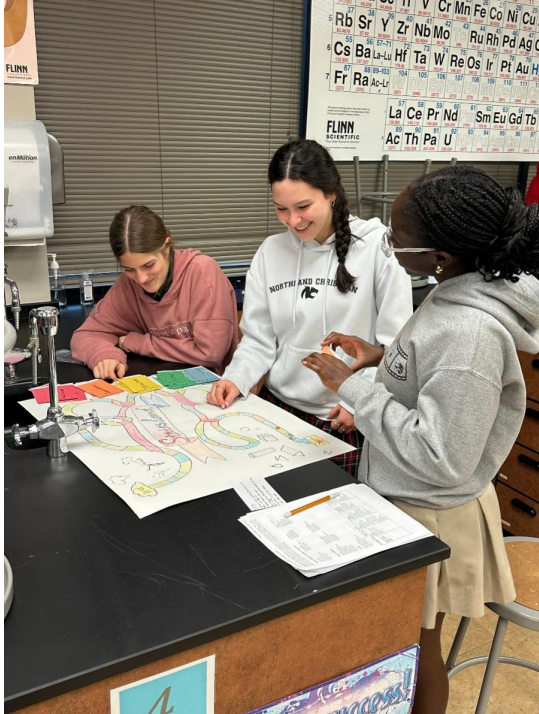
