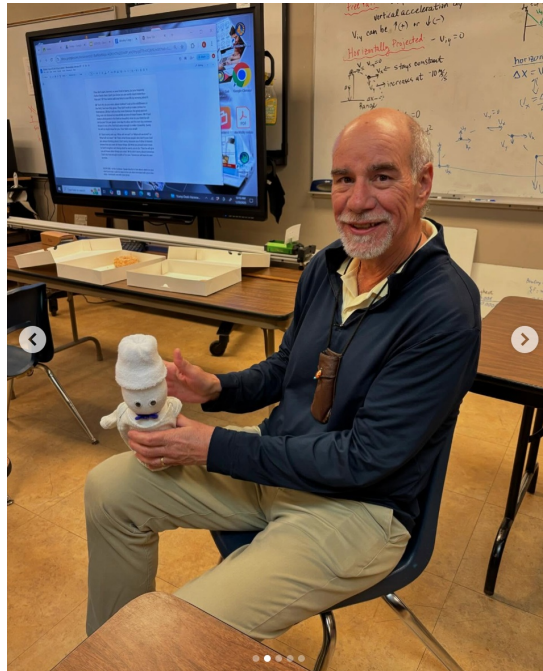
Art
